CPD Requirements

The Danish CPD registration is based on self evaluation. Depending on the number of hours over a rolling 3 years period of time, the members CPD status can be either green, yellow or red.:

Each individual member's registration of CPD result in a "traffic light" indication of how well the member fulfil the requirement for fellow members (or full members). The traffic light can be seen by other members on our website:

If a member has registered CPD of more than 120 hours of CPD over the last 36 months, the member will have a green light.

If a member has registered CPD of between 60 and 120 hours of CPD over the last 36 months, the member will have a "yellow light".

With less than 60 hours, the member does not fulfil the minimum requirements for fellow members, and the member will have a "red light". If a member by the first of January has a red light, the member will lose the "fellow member status" or Full Member status during this calendar year.

If a member in one year has been downgraded from a fellow membership to an affiliated membership due to insufficient CPD registration, and the member register sufficient CPD hours to change the status to yellow or green light, the member automatically regain his or her fellow membership in the following year. Moreover, if a member for urgent reasons wishes to regain a fellow membership during a calendar year, it is possible to ask the Board to confirm the fellow membership during that year if the member first register a sufficient number of CPD hours to change the status to a yellow light.

Den Danske Aktuarforening offers a number of relevant courses during the year. For these, Den Danske Aktuarforening will usually publish the number of CPD hours of the courses. For other educational efforts, it is up to the member to define the relevant time spend on a course.
